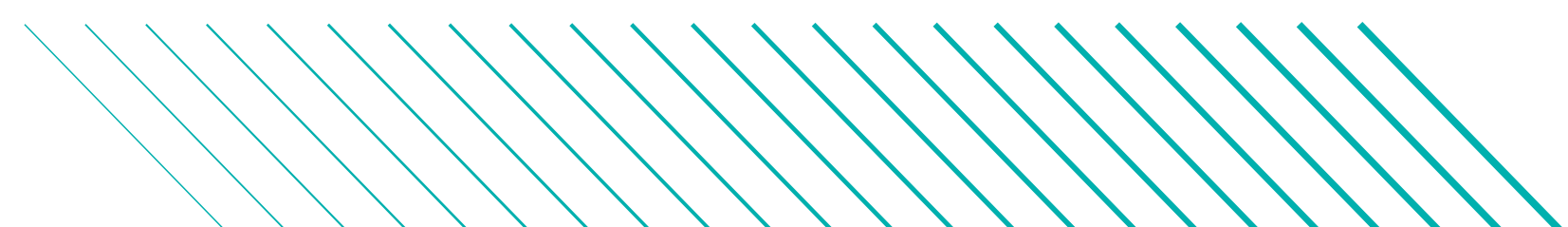

## **PBM Reform**

Ensure adequate reimbursement and fair treatment for LTC pharmacies.

## **Drug Pricing**

Advocate for affordable medications without sacrificing LTC pharmacy viability.

## **Long-Term Care Pharmacy Definition**

Establish our sector's unique role in federal statute.

## **LTC Pharmacy at Home**

Ensure patient access to LTC pharmacy services wherever they live.



# PROVING OUR CASE

SCPC ensures our advocacy and communication efforts are backed by compelling facts and data. We partner with experts at ATI Advisory to uncover critical data and insights to help move our legislative priorities forward.

# MEMBERSHIP DUES

**SCPC Member dues are based on each pharmacy's gross annual revenue.**

For pharmacies with revenues less than \$400 million: Dues are assessed at 0.0004 of gross annual LTC revenues (\$400 for every \$1,000,000).

For pharmacy members with revenues over \$400 million: Dues are assessed at the above millage rate of 0.0004 up to \$400 million. Excess revenues over \$400 million are assessed as follows:

- \$400 million - \$800 million: \$300 for every \$1 million
- \$800 million - 1.2 billion: \$200 for every \$1 million
- More than \$1.2 billion: \$100 for every \$1 million
